INTRODUCTION

- Web-based, active duty survey fielded November 19, 2007 – January 10, 2008
- 63K Service members surveyed, weighted response rate of 33%




 - “NR” indicates the estimate is Not Reportable because it was based on fewer than 30 respondents or the relative standard error was high
 - “NA” indicates the response option was Not Applicable because the question did not apply to respondents in the reporting category based on answers to previous questions

 - Statistically significant changes of more than one percentage point for proportions and five percent for means are highlighted
 - Statistical tests used to compare most recent results with previous results are based on unrounded estimates






Currently Deployed for More Than 30 Days Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Service

Currently Deployed for More Than 30 Days Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade





Percent of Active Duty Members Currently Deployed for More Than 30 Days









Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Service



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Service



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Service




Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade





Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade




























Percent of Applicable Active Duty Members Deployed Since 9-11-01


















Degree of Difficulty in Readjusting to Return Home Percent of Members Deployed Since 9-11-01, but Not Currently Deployed, by Service

Degree of Difficulty in Readjusting to Return Home Percent of Members Deployed Since 9-11-01, but Not Currently Deployed, by Paygrade



Children's Emotional/Behavioral Changes in Response to Deployment


Percent of Members Deployed at Least Once Since 9-11-01 With Children Under 22 Years Old





Percent of Members Deployed Since 9-11-01 With Children Under 22 Years Old











Percent of Active Duty Members Deployed Since 9-11-2001, by Service



Percent of Active Duty Members Deployed Since 9-11-2001, by Paygrade

















Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Service



Percent of All Active Duty Members, by Paygrade









Percent of Active Duty Members Who Used Military OneSource in Past 12 Months, by Service


