Strategic Vision

The Inaugural 2023 DEIA Summit provides distinguished presenters and renowned experts in the fields of government, higher education, business, science, and technology. Each Summit session includes models, new applications, best practices, and live laboratories for testing innovative, theoretical, and practical approaches to address critical issues impacting DoD missions. The Summit consists of two components:

The Leadership Roundtable, Feb 13 and 14. Designed for DoD senior leaders, the Leadership Summit is a closed door session that provides senior leaders the opportunity to grapple with and share experiences of the increasing importance of DEIA on mission readiness. The Leadership Summit is a fertile space for peer-to-peer learning, collaboration, and connection. The session brings together leading authorities on DEIA to discuss the implications and consequences of leading and influencing DEIA advancement within DoD.

The goals and desired outcomes of the Leadership Summit are to gain insight and hard data from industry leaders and academic institutions on how DEIA improves the culture of the organization and increases business operations.

Also, each session will allow DoD to share their initiatives for feedback from our industry and academic partners. Of equal importance the culmination of the Leadership Summit will result in the exposure to and adoption of industry best practices. With an internal focus, DoD leaders will identify actionable solutions to challenges presented in the *DoD-wide DEIA* and talent management crosswalk.

The 2023 DEIA General Summit, Feb 15-17, is a "skills set training" focusing on the professional development of DEIA professionals. It is here that the Summit transitions from the strategic requirements of the Leadership Summit to practical knowledge, offering participants cutting-edge discussions on the innovations of DEIA. Through collaborative conversations among DEIA professionals from government, academia and the private sector, each session integrates critical thinking, reflection, and innovative tools into the dialogue to reframe DEIA in DoD.

Specifically, the desired outcome of the General Summit is to provide thought-leadership and expertise on DEIA that influences policy and practice, that effect employees and customers. Also, DEIA professionals will walk away with enhanced knowledge on specific strategies and practices to move beyond initiative based approaches to behavioral and cultural solutions to current DEIA challenges within DoD. Lastly, the General Summit will forge new relationships and foster unanticipated ideas and vision to enhance DEIA readiness.
