

DoD RESPONSE - DEIA SUMMIT
Suspense: 2/28/23

1. Materials Distributed at Summit

3. Cost of the event:

- Location: No cost to use DoD facility (Jacob Smart Center at Joint Base Andrews)
- Travel: Approximately \$3,000 for travel and lodging for one DoD DMOC employee to support event execution; and one additional local DoD employee.– Planning: No additional costs incurred. Planning costs funded through DoD diversity and inclusion firm fixed price contract that included contractor support for the design of a two-day senior leader and three-day practitioner forum. Non DoD speakers and printing costs equated to ~\$50K

4. Research Presented

- No new DoD research was presented. Participants discussed current research and trends to identify gaps and develop and enact strategies in support of the DoD’s mission challenges. The Summit included models, new applications, best practices, , theoretical, and practical approaches to address critical issues impacting DoD missions through conversations with distinguished presenters and renowned experts in the fields of government, higher education, business, science, and technology.

6. DoD Participants – DoD military, civilians and DoD contractors **registered** for the summit:

Due to the number of virtual attendees, Summit attendance was counted but not tracked. Numbers presented below are by **visual observation** based on room and numbers captured from **virtual guests via Zoom**:

- Monday and Tuesday: ~40 DoD attendees (12 General Officers/Senior Executives)
- Wednesday: ~190 military, civilians and contractors attendees (50 in-person, 140 virtually)
- Thursday: ~180 military, civilians and contractors attendees (50 in-person, 130 virtually)
- Friday: ~115 military, civilians and contractors attendees (25 in-person, 90 virtually)
