


STATEMENT

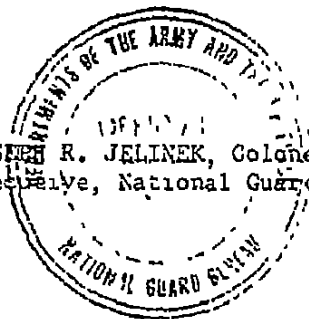

STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

Date: 27 May 68

Place: Ellington AFB, Texas

In connection with my enlistment this date as a Reserve of the Air Force for service in the Air National Guard of the United States, I understand and agree that:


- a. I will enter on active duty for training for 120 days (tour length) or until I have satisfactorily completed the training course which I have elected.
- b. I must enter on such active duty training within 120 days from date of my enlistment, unless I am otherwise qualified for delay under established criteria, but in no event later than 1 year from the date of my enlistment.
- c. If selected for attendance at an Air Force Technical School the duration of which will extend my active duty for training beyond 4 months, I voluntarily agree to remain on active duty for training for the additional period required to complete satisfactorily the course of technical training for which enrolled.
- d. If the AFSC for which enlisted requires OJT beyond 4 months, I voluntarily agree to remain on active duty for the additional period required to satisfactorily complete the prescribed specialty training.
- e. I incur a military service obligation to remain a member of the Air National Guard and as a Reserve of the Air Force for a period of 6 years as required by law; if I am separated from the Air National Guard of the United States for any reason prior to completion of my enlistment, I will be transferred to the Air Force Reserve to complete the remaining portion of my military service obligation and will be subject to further Reserve training as determined by proper authority.
- f. This enlistment in no way relieves me of my obligation to register with the Selective Service System. I understand the voluntary military service obligation which I am assuming will override any classification for which I may be eligible under the Selective Service System.
- g. Provided I satisfactorily participate as a member of the Ready Reserve, I will be deferred from induction; if I fail to participate, I may be involuntarily ordered to perform 45 days' active duty and/or be certified for induction.
- h. Satisfactory participation during my membership in the Air National Guard of the United States will be attendance and satisfactory performance of assigned duties at 45 scheduled inactive duty training periods and 15 days' field training (active duty for training) annually, unless excused therefrom by proper authority. It also includes successful completion of on-the-job upgrade training.
- i. While I am retained as a member of the Ready Reserve, I am subject to involuntary entry into active duty in time of any future emergency proclaimed by the President of the United States or the Congress, or as otherwise provided by law.

j. "I have been counseled this date regarding the provisions of DOD Directive 1215.13, 23 February 1967. I understand that I may be ordered to active duty for a period not to exceed 24 months for unsatisfactory participation as presently defined in Chapter 41, AFM 35-3. Further, I understand that if I am unable to satisfactorily participate in the ANG, and have an unfulfilled military service obligation, that I may be discharged from the State ANG and assigned to the Obligated Reserve Section (ORS), AF Reserve, Denver, Colorado, and subject to active duty for a period not to exceed a total of 24 months considering all previous active duty and active duty for training tours."

k. "However, I also understand that the provisions for invoking the 45 day tour for a member who has a satisfactory attendance record but has failed to progress in specialty training will remain in effect. (Paragraph 42-7a, AFM 35-3.)"

NUMBERING OF COURSES

In general, courses numbered from 10 to 19 are first-year subjects. Second-year or intermediate courses are numbered from 20 to 29. Subjects taken in the Junior and Senior years, particularly those in a student's major, are customarily numbered from 30 to 99. Graduate School courses are numbered 100 and above.

MARKING SYSTEM

The Yale College Faculty voted on November 30, 1967, that as of January 1968 the term grades for all undergraduates are to be designated:

H—Honors
HP—High Pass
P—Pass
F—Fail

These grades have no numerical, letter, or grade-point equivalents.

Numerical Grades (prior to 1968)

Under this system grades were reported in units of one between 60 and 100 (with 60 being the minimum for passing). After July 1, 1963, a student's percentile standing was not recorded unless he specifically so requested. A survey of the grades for several years preceding, however, indicates that a student's average for a given term would rank him approximately as given below:

TERM AVERAGES

81-84	Second Quarter
76-80	Third Quarter
75 and below	Fourth Quarter
60	Minimum passing grade

HONORS Under the numerical system, if a student had no deficiencies on his record and if he ranked in the top ten per cent of his class at a given marking period he was designated a *Ranking Scholar*. Also, the man having no deficiencies and ranking in the top quarter of his class at a marking period was placed on the *Dean's Honor List*.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The Standard Major requires for graduation that 40 term courses be completed with grades of Pass or higher. If a student receives Advanced Standing (i.e., College Credits) for Advanced Placement work taken in secondary school, he may, with permission, use these credits to reduce the number of subjects required for his Yale degree.

The Intensive (or Honors) Major may be allowed to reduce his Junior and Senior year programs to four courses per term. In such instances, 36 courses completed with grades of Pass or higher satisfy the requirements for the degree. As in the case of the Standard Major, a student entering with Advanced Placement work may be permitted to reduce his Yale program accordingly.

With the above noted exceptions, a student's program normally consists of five subjects per term. Most courses meet three times a week for fifty minute periods and are equivalent to three semester hours. Laboratory sessions in which a separate grade is given may be exceptions, and, in such instances, do not usually count as a portion of the customary five course program.

Starting with the class of 1968, the semester hours of credit for each subject are recorded in the column to the right of the term grades.

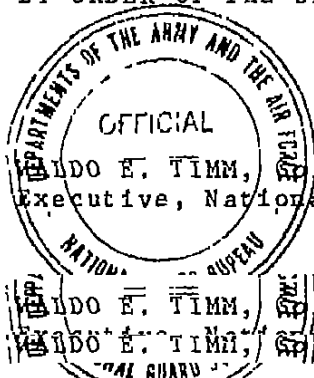


