MEMORANDUM FOR THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE

SUBJECT: Military Relations with Argentina--ACTION MEMORANDUM

Your letter of 17 March to Secretary Vance (TAB B) recommended approval of existing Argentine requests to purchase training and spare parts, to be offered to the Argentines as an incentive for near term substantial improvements in human rights practices in that country. A sequence of intervening events in Argentina -- continuing disappearances, news of the death of two nuns, etc. -- have tempered Secretary Vance's response (TAB C).

The present proposal is that we send a high level team of State Department officials and senior U.S. military officers to voice to GOA officials our continuing concerns, and to identify a range of concrete responses which the USG is prepared to make, in the form of graduated approval of their purchase requests, in exchange for specific GOA commitments to correct their human rights practices.

We have worked with the JCS to identify the DoD officials to participate in this joint mission. Major General Lee E. Surut, Director, Strategy Plans and Policy, Department of Army, would represent the JCS, and Rear Admiral Gordon J. Schuller, Director, Inter-American Region, ISA, would be the OSD representative. I believe Secretary Vance's proposal is sound, and that we should cooperate fully toward that end.

I recommend you sign the letter to Secretary Vance, next under.
