MRS. PERON ALTERS COURSE.

~~(C/NOFORN)~~ The President has announced that she will neither seek reelection nor bow to those calling for her resignation. She has also stated that national elections will be held this year. At the same time, the government has announced the reconvening of Congress next week, only several days after ordering that body's adjournment to thwart impeachment proceedings against the President.

~~(C/NOFORN)~~ These maneuvers are designed to ease the ever-mounting pressures for the President's ouster and are similar to the tactics Mrs. Peron has used before to retain the Presidency. When her advisers have perceived that opposition forces might be seriously threatening the President's tenure, they have effectively silenced -- for the moment at least -- their critics through appeasement.

~~(C/NOFORN)~~ Whether the current tactics are successful remains to be seen. Although Mrs. Peron has probably slowed the movement for her removal, her most important base of support -- labor -- is likely to insist on further concessions. Labor leaders are likely to demand Cabinet changes to replace those recently deposed ministers who were favorably oriented toward the workers' movement. Nonetheless, after a key labor meeting on 18 February to determine that group's position on the current political situation, a profound change was noted. For the first time, labor endorsed a basic support for the institution of the Presidency instead of giving its absolute personal support for Mrs. Peron. This represents a sound defeat for the President in that labor now appears more interested in reorganizing its forces than propping up Mrs. Peron.

Her continued loss of congressional support and only a lukewarm labor endorsement increase the chances that she may still be removed by constitutional means, thus reducing for the moment pressure on the military to remove her. ~~(REFS 2)~~
