(U) Ambassador Robert C. Hill, your predecessor as ASD(ISA) and currently U.S. Ambassador to Argentina, is in the United States on home leave and will be in Washington 31 August to 5 September for consultations. In addition to scheduling him to receive the Soviet Capabilities briefing 1330-1500 hours, 1 September, and to meet with me 1500-1600 hours that same day, I have recommended that Secretary Rumsfeld and Deputy Secretary Clements also receive him.

I expect that Ambassador Hill would raise the issues of continuation of the U.S. Military Group in Argentina; Argentina's continuing interest in the exchange of scientific and technical data on a Service-to-Service basis; continuation of grant training (IMETP) for Argentina; the exclusion of Latin America from attendance at the Senior International Joint Intelligence Course - in sum, the importance of a fruitful military-to-military relationship to U.S./Argentina relations.

(U) In addition to the above issues, I believe you would also be interested in hearing Ambassador Hill's views on Argentina's political and economic future, as well as getting his reaction to the Soviet Capabilities briefing. If you approve, we will confirm the meeting with you and provide appropriate background papers.
