



TOP SECRET (S); SECRET (S); CONFIDENTIAL (C)

WARNING NOTICE - SENSITIVE INTELLIGENCE SOURCES AND METHODS. INVOLVED (WNINTEL). This marking will be prominently displayed on all information and materials relating to sensitive intelligence sources and methods. Materials so marked will not be disseminated in any manner outside authorized channels without the permission of the originating department and an assessment by the senior intelligence officer in the dissen nating department as to the potential risk to the national security and to the intelligence sources and methods involved.

ORIGINATION AND EXTRACTION OF INFO UMATION CONTROLLED BY ORIGINATOR (ORCON). This marking shall be used when unique source sensitivity factors, known to the originator, require strict compliance with third agency rule procedures, in addition to a continuing knowledge and supervision on the part of the originator as to the extent to which the original document and information contained therein is disseminated. Documents and information bearing this marking will not be disseminated beyond the Headquarters elements of the recipient organizations and the information contained therein shall not be extracted and incorporated into other reports without the permission of and under conditions prescribed by the originator.

USIB DEPARTMENTS ONLY (USIBONLY). Poreign intelligence so marked will not be disseminated to departments and agencies not represented on the U.S. Intelligence Board without the permission of the originating agency. The Department of Defense is a USIB member; therefore, items with this marking can be disseminated to all DoD components.

NOT RELEASABLE TO CONTRACTORS OR CONTRACTOR/CONSULTANTS (NOCONTRACT). Foreign intelligence so marked shall not be disseminated to contractors or contractor consultants without the permission of the originating agency. This restriction shall not apply to those consultants hired under Civil Service Commission procedures, or comparable procedures derived from authorities vested in heads of departments and agencies by law, and who are normally considered an extension of the office by which they are employed.

CAUTION - PROPRIETARY INFORMATION IN VOLVED (PROPIN). This marking will be used in conjunction with foreign intelligence obtained from various sources in the U.S. private business sector as the information may bear upon propertary interests of the source or may otherwise be used to the source's detriment. Recipients of reports bearing this marking shall take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the information is not used to the detriment of the source. (This control marking cannot be used alone. When it is used, the control marking "NOCONTRACT" must also be used.)

NOT RELEASABLE TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (NOFORN). Foreign intelligence so marked involves special considerations requiring that it not be released in any form to foreign governments, foreign nationals, or non-U.S. citizens without the permission of the originating agency.

THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE FOR THING (Specified Countries) (REL Specified Countries). This marking Will may be used when the originating agency predetermines that information can be released to specified foreign governments.

sume the Presidency is increasing speculation in Argentina that the military will prevent her from doing so. Consequently, her planned resumption of office on 17 October is still uncertain.

(Symples of the unfavorable political and public reaction that would ensue. Neventheless, most of the military leaders do not want Mrs. Peron to continue in office. The army commander and the majority of his senior officers prefer that the President take extended leave or resign rather than be ousted, contending that she lacks the ability and physical stamina needed to correct the country's pressing political, economic, and internal-security problems.

be open. Military and anti-Peronist forces could permit Mrs. Peron to resume the Presidency on a figurehead basis with the Ministers of Economy and Interior actually running the government. This approach would save the armed forces the negative reaction they would encounter from loyal Peronists should she be ousted by them. At the same time, it would tend to mollify those who oppose her altogether. On the other hand, military leaders could convince Mrs. Peron that she should remain on leave or resign, thus leaving the government in the hands of interim President Italo Luder.

(s/Norenn/Manual) On balance, the first alternative appears more likely because the military's principal complaints -- alleged government tolerance of and inaction against terrorism -- have been satisfied somewhat. Establishment of the National Defense and Internal Security Councils on 6 October to deal
