



WARNING NOTICE - SENSITIVE INTELLIGENCE SOURCES AND METHODS INVOLVED (WNINTEL) This marking will be prominently displayed on all information and materials relating to sensitive intelligence sources and methods. Materials so marked will not be disseminated in any manner outside authorized channels without the permission of the originating department and an assessment by the senior intelligence officer in the disseminating department as to the potential risk to the national security and to the intelligence sources and methods involved.

DISSEMINATION AND EXTRACTION OF INFORMATION CONTROLLED BY ORIGINATOR (ORCON). This marking shall be used when unique source sensitivity factors, known to the originator, require strict compliance with third agency rule procedures, in addition to a continuing knowledge and supervision on the part of the originator as to the extent to which the original document and information contained therein is disseminated. Documents and information bearing this marking will not be disseminated beyond the Headquarters elements of the recipient organizations and the information contained therein shall not be extracted and incorporated into other reports without the permission of and under conditions prescribed by the originator.

USIB DEPARTMENTS ONLY (USIBONLY). Foreign intelligence so marked will not be disseminated to departments and agencies not represented on the U.S. Intelligence Board without the permission of the originating agency. The Department of Defense is a USIB member: therefore, items with this marking can be disseminated to all DOD components.

NOT RELEASABLE TO CONTRACTORS OR CONTRACTOR/CONSULTANTS (NOCONTRACT). Poreign intelligence so marked shall not be disseminated to contractors or contractor consultants without the permission of the originating agency. This restriction shall not apply to those consultants hired under Civil Service Commission procedures, or comparable procedures derived from authoritles vested in heads of departments and agencies by law, and who are normally considered an extension of the office by which they are employed.

CAUTION - PROPRIETARY INFORMATION INVOLVED (PROFIN). This marking will be used in conjunction with foreign intelligence obtained from various sources in the U.S. private business sector as the information may bear upon propietary interests of the source of may otherwise be used to the source's detriment. Reciplents of reports bearing this marking shall take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the information is not used to the detriment of the source. (This control marking cannot be used alone. When it is used, the control marking "NOCONTRACT" must also be used.)

NOT RELEASABLE TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (NOFORN). Foreign intelligence so marked involves special considerations requiring that it not be released in any form to foreign governments, foreign nationals, or non-U.S. citizens without the permission of the originating agency.

THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE TO (Specified Countries) (REL Specified Countries). This marking may be used when the originating agency predetermines that information can be released to specified foreign governments.

REVOLT ENDS.

(C/NOFORN) The settlement that ended the air force rebellion on 22 December most likely calls for President Peron's removal within 30 days.

(G/NOTODN/LINETED) The rebels' only confirmed success was the forced retirement of the air force commander. However, the agreement between the rebels and service chiefs reportedly calls for a limit to Mrs. Peron's tenure in office. Although details are sketchy, all concerned believe a move must be made by the end of January. Apparently, the only discipline for the dissidents will be the forced retirement of their leader, Gen Capellini. The air bases they seized have been relinquished, but some ineffectual resistance continues.

(c)(Nerona) As a further discredit to the administration, a federal judge ordered the arrest of the President's trusted personal adviser and former Social Welfare Minister -- Jose Lopez Rega -- his successor in the ministry, and an aide. The three are charged with falsifying documents and misusing public funds. Spain will be asked to extradite Lopez Rega, but he will probably not return from Madrid to answer the charges.

(c/Morona/(Manager) Meanwhile, in terrorist activity, leftists recently tried to kill two admirals, the Navy Chief of Staff and the Chief of Naval Aviation. The incident reflects a reaction to recently increased antiterrorist activities by the military.
