# ARGENTINA

## PRESIDENT MAY RESIGN.

(C/NPD) The Argentine Naval Attache in Washington states that President Isabel Peron will resign within the next two weeks and that the armed forces will assume control pending new elections.

(C/NPD) This uncorroborated information is considered accurate by the source, since he believes that the only other alternative to the resignation would be civil war. The Argentine military, formerly unwilling to intervene in the political situation developing between Mrs Peron and organized labor over wage increases, may now view the climate in Argentina as requiring such action to prevent chaos.

(C/NPD) Under the recently enacted Law of Succession, provisional president of the Senate Italo Luder would become chief executive. The willingness of the military to permit Luder to retain the Presidency for a prolonged period is in doubt, however. (CDC 31 Dec 81)
