

KEY TO CLASSIFICATION AND HANDLING CAVEAT ABBREVIATIONS USED IN DEFENSE INTELLIGENCE AGENCY CURRENT INTELLIGENCE PUBLICATIONS.

TOP SECRET (TS); SECRET (S); CONFIDENTIAL (C)

WARNING NOTICE - SENSITIVE INTELLIGENCE SOURCES AND METHODS INVOLVED (WNINTEL). This marking will be prominently displayed on all information and materials relating to sensitive intelligence sources and methods. Materials so marked will not be disseminated in any manner outside authorized channels without the permission of the originating department and an assessment by the senior intelligence officer in the disseminating department as to the potential risk to the national security and to the intelligence sources and methods involved.

DISSEMINATION AND EXTRACTION OF INFORMATION CONTROLLED BY ORIGINATOR (ORCON). This marking shall be used when unique source sensitivity factors, known to the originator, require strict compliance with third agency rule procedures, in addition to a continuing knowledge and supervision on the part of the originator as to the extent to which the original document and information contained therein is disseminated. Documents and information bearing this marking will not be disseminated beyond the Headquarters elements of the recipient organizations and the information contained therein shall not be extracted and incorporated into other reports without the permission of and under conditions prescribed by the originator.

USIB DEPARTMENTS ONLY (USIBONLY). Foreign intelligence so marked will not be disseminated to departments and agencies not represented on the U.S. Intelligence Board without the permission of the originating agency. The Department of Defense is a USIB member; therefore, items with this marking can be disseminated to all DoD components.

NOT RELEASABLE TO CONTRACTORS OR CONTRACTOR/CONSULTANTS (NOCONTRACT). Foreign intelligence so marked shall not be disseminated to contractors or contractor consultants without the permission of the originating agency. This restriction shall not apply to those consultants hired under Civil Service Commission procedures, or comparable procedures derived from authorities vested in heads of departments and agencies by law, and who are normally considered an extension of the office by which they are employed.

CAUTION - PROFRIETARY INFORMATION INVOLVED (PROPIN). This marking will be used in conjunction with foreign intelligence obtained from various sources in the U.S. private business sector as the information may bear upon propietary interests of the source or may otherwise be used to the source's detriment. Recipients of reports bearing this marking shall take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the information is not used to the detriment of the source. (This control marking cannot be used alone. When it is used, the control marking "NOCONTRACT" must also be used.)

NOT RELEASABLE TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (NOFORN). Foreign intelligence so marked involves special considerations requiring that it not be released in any form to foreign governments, foreign nationals, or non-U.S. citizens without the permission of the originating agency.

THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE TO (Specified Countries) (REL Specified Countries). This marking may be used when the originating agency predetermines that information can be released to specified foreign governments.

AIR FORCE REVOLT ENDS.

(C/NOTONN/WNINTEL) The 18 December rebellion of air force officers has ended, but has resulted in the retirement of that service's pro-Peronist commander. Gen Hector Fautario, who has never been especially popular with his subordinates, has been replaced by Gen Orlando Ramon Agosti.

(S/NOTORN/WNINTED) Gen Fautario was released by his captives yesterday afternoon when they realized they could not win the support of all air force units or the army and navy. Soon after resuming his command, Fautario announced his retirement. Agosti's appointment in turn forced several other generals senior to him to resign.

(5/NOFORN/WHINTEE) Although the rebels said they were motivated by recent "arbitrary" promotions and transfers, the motive for the act was probably Gen Cappellini's long-time personal conflict with Fautario. The former commander had reportedly learned that Cappellini was involved in coup plotting and asked him to accept an undesirable position abroad or retire -- setting the stage for Cappellini to lead the revolt. To gain support and justify their move the rebellious officers issued communiques asking the army and navy to join them in "overthrowing public authority to achieve the restoration of a new order with a national and Christian sense." They also demanded that Mrs. Peron be replaced by Army Commander Gen Videla who was in Caracas, Venezuela, during the uprising. The affair resulted in the army and navy being placed on alert; however, there is no evidence that any units of these services supported the rebels' call.

(C (NOFORM (MITMET) The revolt was probably carried out while Videla was out of the country because the general opposes military intervention at this time. The rebel officers apparently believed that during Videla's absence they could persuade the army and navy to support their move to oust Mrs. Peron, since they realized that no coup would likely succeed without army backing. Although the officers failed in this attempt, their cause still may not be lost. With Gen Agosti's reportedly strong anti-Peronist attitude, the day may be near when the army, navy, and air force can agree on a way to oust the discredited Peron government.
