WARNING NOTICE - SENSITIVE INTELLIGENCE SOURCES AND METHODS INVOLVED (WNINTEL). This marking will be prominently displayed on all information and materials relating to sensitive intelligence sources and methods. Materials so marked will not be disseminated in any manner outside authorized channels without the permission of the originating department and an assessment by the senior intelligence officer in the disseminating department as to the potential risk to the national security and to the intelligence sources and methods involved.

DISSEMINATION AND EXTRACTION OF INFORMATION CONTROLLED BY ORIGINATOR (ORCON). This marking shall be used when unique source sensitivity factors, known to the originator, require strict compliance with third agency rule procedures, in addition to a continuing knowledge and supervision on the part of the originator as to the extent to which the original document and information contained therein is disseminated. Documents and information bearing this marking will not be disseminated beyond the Headquarters elements of the recipient organizations and the information contained therein shall not be extracted and incorporated into other reports without the permission of and under conditions prescribed by the originator.

USIB DEPARTMENTS ONLY (USIBONLY). Foreign intelligence so marked will not be disseminated to departments and agencies not represented on the U.S. Intelligence Board without the permission of the originating agency. The Department of Defense is a USIB member; therefore, items with this marking can be disseminated to all DoD components.

NOT RELEASABLE TO CONTRACTORS OR CONTRACTOR/CONSULTANTS (NOCONTRACT). Foreign intelligence so marked shall not be disseminated to contractors or contractor consultants without the permission of the originating agency. This restriction shall not apply to those consultants hired under Civil Service Commission procedures, or comparable procedures derived from authorities vested in heads of departments and agencies by law, and who are normally considered an extension of the office by which they are employed.

CAUTION - PROPRIETARY INFORMATION INVOLVED (PROPIN). This marking will be used in conjunction with foreign intelligence obtained from various sources in the U.S. private business sector as the information may bear upon proprietary interests of the source or may otherwise be used to the source's detriment. Recipients of reports bearing this marking shall take every reasonable precaution to ensure that the information is not used to the detriment of the source. (This control marking cannot be used alone. When it is used, the control marking "NOCONTRACT" must also be used.)

NOT RELEASABLE TO FOREIGN NATIONALS (NOFORN). Foreign intelligence so marked involves special considerations requiring that it not be released in any form to foreign governments, foreign nationals, or non-U.S. citizens without the permission of the originating agency.

THIS INFORMATION HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE TO (Specified Countries) (REL Specified Countries). This marking may be used when the originating agency predetermines that information can be released to specified foreign governments.

AIR FORCE REBELLION ALMOST OVER.

~~(S/NOFORN/WHINTTEL)~~ The Air Force rebellion in Argentina has all but ended. However, the situation which led to the rebellion, the desire to have the President removed from office, remains unresolved.

~~(S/NOFORN/WHINTTEL)~~ The air force rebels for all practical purposes have failed in their efforts to gain support from the army, navy, and all other air elements. When army General Mujica, Director of the Army War College and a long-time advocate of military coups, declared support for the rebels, he was quickly dismissed by Army Commander Videla. So far there have been no repercussions from the army or other services over this action.

~~(S/NOFORN/WHINTTEL)~~ Even though the rebels have called for an all military regime to replace Mrs. Peron, they would probably accept an agreement for her to take leave of absence or resign. Along these lines, General Videla reportedly has dissuaded some generals from joining the rebellion by promising to overthrow the government within ten days after the rebellion has ended if Mrs. Peron remains in office. The majority of the armed forces are still thought to support a constitutional solution to the political crisis, and the service chiefs will undoubtedly pressure the Cabinet and ranking Peronist congressional members to convince Mrs. Peron that she should take a prolonged leave or resign.

~~(S/NOFORN/WHINTTEL)~~ Mrs. Peron has thus far refused to step aside, although she is reportedly ill and under medical care. For the most part she remains secluded with only a few of her supporters. Her most likely course of action now appears to be to go on leave, which would result in her constitutional successor, Italo Luder, assuming the presidency. Such an occurrence would probably satisfy the armed forces, at least for the time being.
