(S//NF//WD//SI//NF) Foreign Minister Robledo allegedly suggested that Army Commander-in-Chief (CINC) Gen Numa Laplane resign to ease the crisis, since Laplane approved the Damasco appointment without the prior consent of the other CINCs. Having the backing of the President, Laplane and Damasco could take action to force the ouster of their detractors, especially Navy Commander Adm Massera and Air Force Commander Gen Fautario. However, such a move would likely result in reaction from the remainder of the military opposed to Damasco.
