## Why Military Security Assistance to Argentina

- Together with Chile, geographically dominates the ocean routes between the South Atlantic and Pacific Oceans that transit the Drake Passage, Beagle Channel and Straits of Magellan.
- Argentina has important influence in South America because of its relatively advanced economy and culture.
- Preempt incursion of third powers with interests inimical to US.
- Maintain US as predominant influence on the Argentina military.
- Sustain Argentina's capabilities to counter insurgent threat.
- Contribute to modest modernization efforts.

Urban terrorism, including bombings, murders, kidnappings, as well as raids on urban military installations, has been a serious problem in Argentina since April 1969. Rural insurgency also is becoming a serious problem. Although domestic tranquility has been disturbed by the prolonged terrorism, Argentina's police and armed forces will be able to contain insurgent activity for the foreseeable future.
