- USCINCSO reports that the MAAGs in Brazil, Argentina, Venezuela, Colombia, Chile, Peru, Ecuador, Panama, Nicaragua, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Uruguay, Honduras and El Salvador are "high priority". Of "lesser priority" is the MAAG in Bolivia. USCINCSO recommends elimination of the MAAGs in Paraguay and Costa Rica. The JCS differ with the view of USCINCSO relative to Paraguay, suggesting that it be placed in the "lesser priority" category.

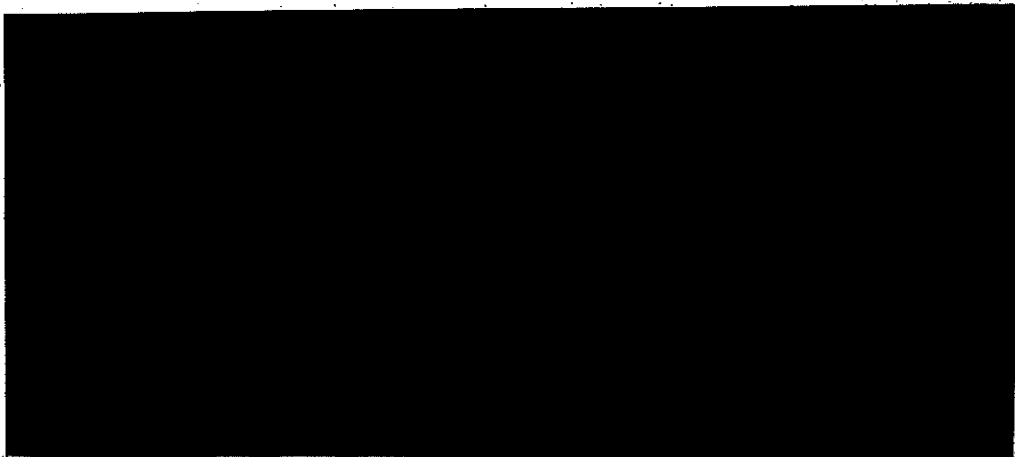

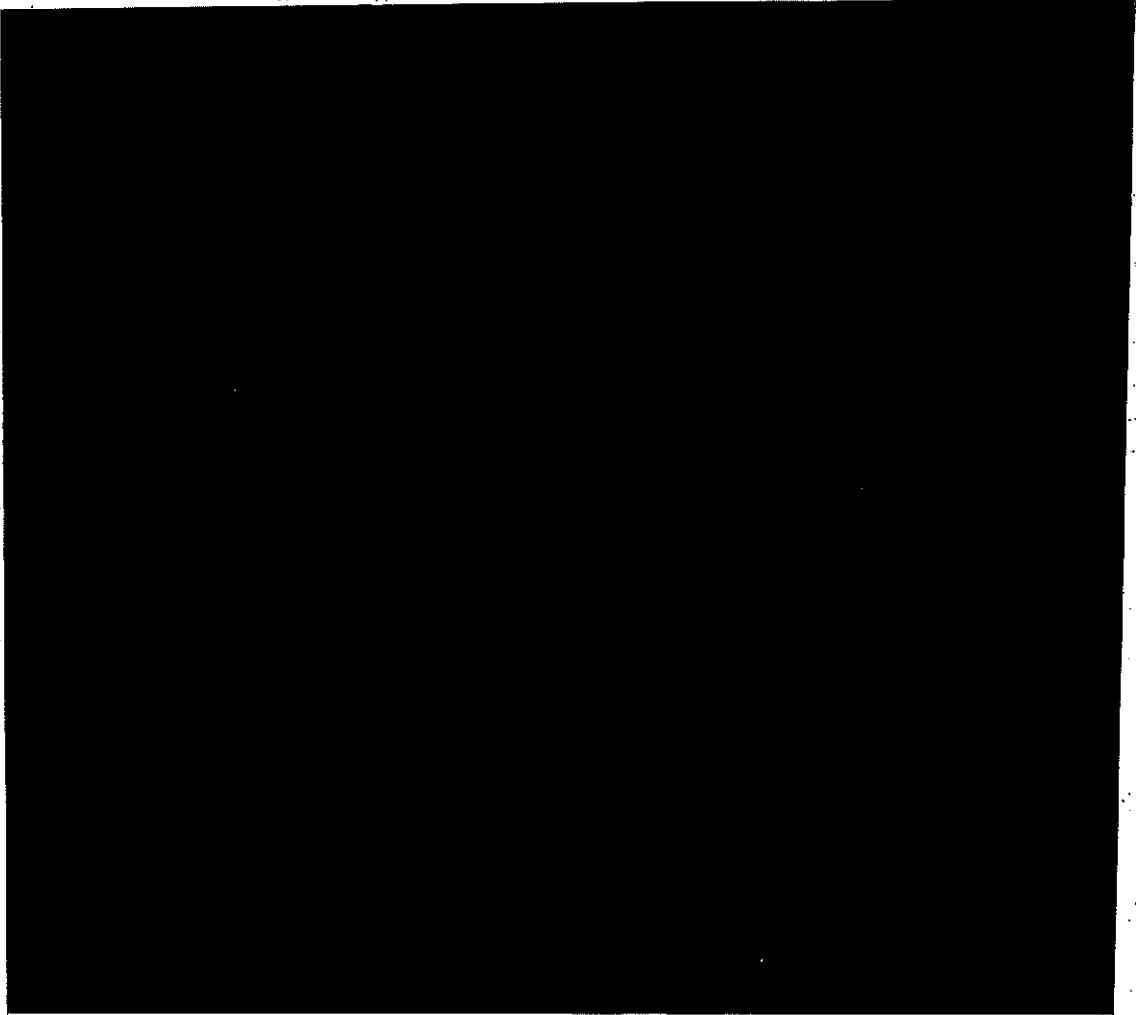
