Amount: \$9,000,000 B.

C. Type of Credit: Guaranty

Military Justification: Argentina is the second largest D. country in South America and controls the passageway between the South Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. Argentina is important because of its size, location and its relatively advanced culture and economy which makes it influential in South America. U.S. security objectives in Argentina are designed to strengthen and support U.S.-Argentina political relations and military cooperation.
