☞ This is to inform you that the FY 1976 MAP training levels for Argentina, Ecuador, and Haiti will exceed the FY 1975 MAP training levels as noted below:

Country	MAP Training Levels	
	FY 1975	FY 1976
Argentina	\$100,000	\$920,000
Ecuador	400,000	930,000
Haiti	28,000	200,000

☞ MAP training for Argentina was suspended in late FY 1974 under the provisions of Section 620 (a)(3) of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961, as amended. The suspension was lifted in May 1975 and \$100,000 was allocated for training for the remainder of FY 1975.

(U) The FY 1975 levels for Ecuador and Haiti represent the resumption of limited MAP training during that fiscal year.
