#### Department of Defense Response to USAI-Related FOIA Request

#### **Key Points**

- Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington filed a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) lawsuit in federal district court against the Department of Defense (DoD), Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and Department of State (State) seeking certain communications relating to the Ukraine Security Assistance Initiative (USAI).
- On February 28, 2020, DoD produced the following 61 pages of documents pursuant to a joint status report filed with the court on January 24, 2020.
- This production is consistent with DoD's standard practice of invoking reasonably available exemptions under the FOIA statute.
- These exemptions include personnel privacy, classified information, sensitive foreign government information, and Executive Branch deliberative process.
